



In Cygnets this term children will be learning about the Me and My Shadow

In Computing children will be learning to log on to a computer and also how to control a mouse. Once we have learnt to do this we will start to learn about algorithms.

In English we will be reading and writing using three stories these are Astro Girl a story of a little girl who wants to be an astronaut we will be continuing to learn about noun phrases and increasing the adjectives that we can use to describe. Our second book Beegu is a little alien who lands on Earth. We will negotiate how he gets back to his parents. Our last story is called the Comet. It tells the story of Nyla who is dealing with the confusion of moving house, an experience many children will be able to relate to, and provides a context for discussing themes of belonging, change and finding comfort.

In PE reception and year one will continue their trips to Forest school. On a Monday Miss Ell will continue teaching all three year groups. On a Thursday the children will have multiskills and how to stay healthy.

In Science, children will learn about their seasons, change and weather. We will think about the months of the year.

In Music children will be learning to perform songs. We will also be continuing to learn to play the ocarina.

Me and My Shadow

In Art we will be exploring colours and drawing detailed pictures of we will be also making a 3D Christmas bird. In design technology we will be learning to make a moving book.

In Geography children will be learning about Southrop and what it looks like. We will be observing maps and also looking at aerial photos.

In RE, children will explore Christmas and what happened in the first ever Christmas. The children will learn the term incarnation which means in the flesh. The children will learn about all the vital members of the story and how each of them might have felt during the story.

In Reception, children will begin by learning to count forwards and backwards up to 10. The children will be learning to order and count out specifically the amounts. The children will also be thinking about more and less.

In Year 1, children will be working with numbers up to 100 and exploring place value using ten frames. They will learn about more and less whilst looking at the place value in each number.

In Year 2, children will use tens and ones to investigate and understand the structure of numbers. They will work with numbers up to 100, applying this knowledge to addition and subtraction activities.
