



In Cygnets this term children will be learning about Famous for five Minutes

In Computing children will be creating rockets on a computer using a mouse. The children will then be setting their own rockets up into space.

In English we will be reading the story Beegu and producing a help sheet for her to return home. We will also be reading the story the Owl and the Pussycat and the wolves.



In Science children will learn about materials and how they are used. The children will complete some scientific experiments to find out what materials are the strongest or weakest.

In Music we will learn that music is made of high and low sounds, long and short sounds, and loud and quiet sounds. We will use these to make our own songs and melodies. We will also be continuing to learn to play the ocarina.

In Art we will be using junk to create models the year two will be extended to be architects.

In PE reception and year one will continue their trips to Forest school. On a Monday Miss Ell will continue teaching all three year groups at hall and will be teaching gymnastics. On a Thursday we will be leaning to play ball games.

In History children will be learning about explorers throughout history. They will learn to Explain what explorers do. They will name equipment or transport an explorer would need. They will be able to sequence four photographs from different periods of time. Name important explorers (e.g. Christopher Columbus, Dame Ellen MacArthur, Matthew Henson and Mary Kingsley). Identify where they travelled and write a sentence about the achievements of one explorer. Select the most important events in a historical story.

In Religious Education children in year one and two will be learning about who is Jewish and how do they live? We will recognise the words of the Shema as a Jewish prayer. Children will retell stories and we will learn to give examples of how the stories used in celebrations. In Reception children will be learning about special events and when they feel special and by the end of the term will be able to Share and record occasions when things have happened in their lives that made them feel special Retell religious stories, making connections with personal experiences.

In Maths children in reception will be focusing on writing their numbers and matching quantities to the number.

In year one children will be learning to partition numbers up to 16. Learning about the addition and subtractions and matching numbers. They will also be learning about 3D shapes and measuring using a non standard unit.

In year two children will start with learning about division and multiplication. We will then be learning about geometry learning about direction. Later in the tern we will be learning our 2s, 3's, 5's and 10 times tables.
