



In Cygnets this term children will be learning about the Superheroes

In Computing the children will be learning about computers and the inputs and outputs work understanding how computers are used in the wider World.

In English we will be reading the story ***Send for a Superhero*** where we will meet the villains Vacuum and Filth. The children will explore writing for different purposes.

In PE reception and year one will continue their trips to Forest school. On a Monday Miss Ell will continue teaching all three year groups, they will be learning multiskills activities. On a Thursday the children will have ball games.

In Science, children are learning to explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. They learn how to identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats; and describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.

In Music children will be learning when voices or instruments work together to play different pitches that sound at the same time, we can hear harmony in music! They will explore the voices and instruments used within the music in this unit to identify how and when harmonies take place. How many different instruments can you recognise.

In Art we will be exploring colours and painting using water colour. We will be mixing the primary colours and creating our own art work. We will also be learning about famous artists.

In Geography, the children will be learning about the four parts of the United Kingdom: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. They will learn how to locate the UK on a world map and identify its position within Europe. Throughout these lessons, the children will develop their map-reading skills, including how to use and read a compass. They will also explore the four seasons and understand how weather changes throughout the year.

In RE, the children will be learning about Easter. They will learn about Holy Week and what impact this had. We will think about the emotions that the disciples and Jesus' followers felt. We will discover how Easter is celebrated world wide.

In Reception, children will begin by learning to count forwards and backwards up to 20. We will consolidate counting out objects and combining small groups. In Year 1, children will be working with numbers up to 20 addition and subtraction for the numbers 16-20. Then they will learn about fractions. In Year 2, will be continuing to learn how to measure using different measurements. Then they will learn about fractions starting by learning thirds and quarters.
